Jumper judges for the two-week Spring Festival include Jay Mullen and Jackie Gazzara. Hunter judges for week one includes Brian Lenehan, Tony Sgarlata, Andrea Wells, and Meg Black. Hunter judges for week two include Gary Duffy, David Wilbur, and Ken Whelihan. Robert Crawford will be on hand both weeks as a USEF Steward working with Shelia Murphy during week one and Andi Hengen for week two.

Fieldstone Show Park is hosting an extended show schedule this summer, including six weeks of competition, featuring three FEI CSI 2* shows on their grounds in Halifax. The Fieldstone Show Park's Spring Festival will take course over a two-week period. The first week of the Spring Festival will run from May 6-10, with the second week of the Festival running May 13-17.



Brian Lenehan of Palm Beach Gardens, FL, is a well-known and respected horseman. Inducted into the Show Hunter Hall of Fame in 2014, Brian is an "R" rated judge. He has judged many top hunter and equitation riders at shows such as Harrisburg, Upperville, Lake Placid, WEF, Traders Point, HITS Ocala, HITS on the Hudson, Kentucky, Vermont and many more.

Gary Duffy of Palm Beach, Florida comes to the Fieldstone Horse Show Spring Festival from his farm, Little Brook Farms. Gary is an "R" rated USEF judge and well-respected horseman in both the hunters and equitation. The Del Mar International and Hampton Classic are just two examples of the many top shows where he has judged.

David Wilbur owns and operates Wilbur Show Stables in Ocala, Florida with his wife Maari. David and Maari opened the farm in 2005 after successful years working under other well-known industry professionals. With experience in the Mini Prix, Grand Prix, Hunter

Derby, and many other show rings, David will bring his well-rounded knowledge to the Fieldstone Show grounds! David is an "R" rated USEF judge.



Ken Whelihan of Otis, MA is the resident trainer of Berkshire Equestrian Center. Ken is a recognized "R" rated USEF judge commended for his endless knowledge and professionalism. Ken has been a familiar face in the hunter and equitation arenas for over 20 years. Additionally, Ken has coached riders through Marshall and Sterling, New England, and Connecticut finals, also producing a USEF Horse of the Year and multiple Grand Prix winning horses.

Course designers for week one will be Danny Foster doing the jumpers and Tom Hern doing the hunters. Week Two will have Patrick Muskus doing the jumpers with Tom Hern again taking care of the hunters.
