## PRIZE MONEY

Prize Money will be applied to your bill. Any prize money over the amount of the bill will be mailed within 30 days of the close of the competition.

Checks will be payable to the owner, unless otherwise stated and will be paid only when the SS# or Federal Tax ID# has been provided to the Horse Show office by completion of the Prize Money Check Request Form and entry blank and will receive an IRS Form 1099. \*Please confirm information on entry form is correct to insure prompt and accurate delivery of prize money. USEF GR: 1210.6

## PRIZE MONEY — CAVEAT RULE

The caveat rules are in place for prize money classes due to the uncertainty of entries, weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

### Classes with \$20,000 in prize money requires 20 entries.

Less than 20 entries, the prize money will be the following:  
15 to 19 entries, the prize money is \$15,000 with a \$350 entry fee  
10 to 14 entries, the prize money is \$10,000 with a \$250 entry fee  
5 to 9 entries, the prize money is \$5,000 with a \$200 entry fee

### Classes with \$15,000 in prize money requires 18 entries.

Less than 18 entries, the prize money will be the following:  
15 to 17 entries, the prize money is \$7,500 with a \$250 entry fee  
10 to 14 entries, the prize money is \$5,000 with a \$200 entry fee  
5 to 9 entries, the prize money is \$2,500 with a \$150 entry fee

### Classes with \$10,000 in prize money requires 18 entries.

Less than 18 entries, the prize money will be the following:  
15 to 17 entries, the prize money is \$7,500 with a \$250 entry fee  
10 to 14 entries, the prize money is \$5,000 with a \$200 entry fee  
5 to 9 entries, the prize money is \$2,500 with a \$150 entry fee

### Classes with \$7,500 in prize money requires 18 entries.

Less than 18 entries, the prize money will be the following:  
15-17 entries, the prize money is \$5,000 with a \$200 entry fee  
10-14 entries, the prize money is \$2,500 with a \$150 entry fee  
5 to 9 entries, the prize money is \$2,000 with a \$100 entry fee

### Classes with \$5,000 in prize money require 18 entries.

Less than 18 entries, the prize money will be the following:  
15 to 17 entries, the prize money is \$3,000 with a \$150 entry fee  
10 to 14 entries, the prize money is \$1,500 with a \$125 entry fee  
5 to 9 entries, the prize money is \$1,000 with a \$100 entry fee

### Classes with \$2,500 in prize money require 18 entries.

Less than 18 entries, the prize money will be the following:  
15 to 17 entries, the prize money is \$1,500 with a \$150 entry fee  
10 to 14 entries, the prize money is \$1,000 with a \$125 entry fee  
5 to 9 entries, the prize money is \$500 with a \$75 entry fee

### Classes with \$2,000 in prize money require 18 entries.

Less than 18 entries, the prize money will be the following:  
15 to 17 entries, the prize money is \$1500 with a \$150 entry fee  
10 to 14 entries, the prize money is \$1000 with a \$100 entry fee  
5 to 9 entries, the prize money is \$500 with a \$75 entry fee

### Classes with \$1,500 in prize money require 18 entries.

Less than 18 entries, the prize money will be the following:  
15 to 17 entries, the prize money is \$1,000 with a \$125 entry fee  
10 to 14 entries, the prize money is \$750 with a \$100 entry fee  
5 to 9 entries, the prize money is \$500 with a \$75 entry fee

### Classes with \$1,000 in prize money require 18 entries.

Less than 18, the prize money will be the following:  
15 to 17 entries, the prize money is \$750 with a \$100 entry fee  
10 to 14 entries, the prize money is \$500 with a \$75 entry fee  
5 to 9 entries, the prize money is \$250 with a \$50 entry fee

ALL CLASSICS, GRAND PRIXS & HUNTER DERBIES with prize money requires that the horse MUST compete in at least one other class at this competition.

All Jumper classes with prize money require 6 entries or the class may be combined, cancelled or prize money deleted.

Hunter Derbies/Classics with prize money require 6 entries or the classes may be combined or cancelled.

JR/AO Jumpers requires 6 entries in each high & low otherwise the class will run as a combined JR/AO High/Low.

## DECLARATIONS

Grand Prix Riders must declare in the Show Office in accordance with grand prix standards.

## TIES

All ties involving first place shall be jumped off. For all other ties, time taken to complete the first round will decide, unless otherwise stated.

## TIME ALLOWED

Based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute.

## ATTIRE

Formal attire is requested for the Children's Jumper Classic, Adult Amateur Jumper Classic, Junior/Amateur Owner Low Jumper Classic, Junior/Amateur Owner High Jumper Classic and required for the Grand Prix. The Management, at its discretion, may allow riders to compete without riding coats. If a riding coat is not worn, riders must wear a shirt with a collar or choker, neatly tucked into riding breeches. A raincoat may be worn if conditions require. In all cases, riders must appear neatly attired.

## RING DIMENSIONS AND FOOTING

Grand Prix Field — 350' x 400'

Athletic turf grass

Ring 1 — 175' x 240'

Full drainage with GGT Elastic Jumper Blend

Ring 3 — 125' x 210'

## SCRATCH REFUNDS

Scratches before the close of entries all fees will be refunded upon receipt of written instructions to scratch the entry.

Scratches after the close of pre-entry date and before the start of the show, a full refund of all entry fees except stall fees, \$50 office fee, and \$50 scratch fee.

Scratches after the start of the show and before any class enter into a full refund of all entry fees except stall fees, \$50 office fee and a \$50 scratch fee. 50% of nominating fee.

No refund for classes entered and not scratched during the show. Entry fees shall be refunded only upon presentation of a statement signed by the Official Show Veterinarian (or a medical doctor in the case of an Amateur-Owner or Equitation rider) stating that the horse (rider) is unable to perform in the class(es) entered.

If a Nominated Jumper does not show in any jumper class requiring the nominating fee, a refund of 50% of the nominating fee will be given. A Nominated Jumper may not scratch a class on the same day as that class without an Official Show Veterinarian certificate. If a Nominated Jumper scratches with a vet certificate a \$50 scratch fee and a \$50 office fee will apply.

The office fee is non-refundable under any circumstances after the entries close.

## POLING

Poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets and/or who, on the opinion of the judges or committee, uses their whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a 24 hour period, and will forfeit entry fees for that class. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offset rule is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for a 24 hour period starting from the time of the incident, and will forfeit all entry fees. Any further violations by that exhibitor on the same horse or another horse will result in said exhibitor being barred from any further competition at the show.

## PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR

Protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries an SEI tag must be worn by all riders at all times while mounted on a horse or pony. Head gear must be properly fitted with the harness secured at all times. (See Rule GR 801)

## MEDICAL WASTE

Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles.

Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by show management

## SHOW MANAGEMENT

The Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, make changes or split any class, if entries warrant. The Management rule is that 4 horses is considered a class is filled. The rules of the USEF require it.

The Management also reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show, to move classes to another ring, and to decline any entry and to return money owed before or during the show without being liable for compensation.

## SHOW VETERINARIAN

Official Show Veterinarian's phone number will be posted at the Horse Show Office.

## DOGS

No dogs or other pets allowed on the grounds unless they are leashed and under control. Unrestrained pets will be impounded and released only upon payment of a \$50.00 fine

## DOTTED LINES

A dotted line may be used in any ring at management's discretion.

## SCHOOLING

No schooling will be permitted, at any time, in any of the show rings, except during a scheduled warm-up class.

**Use the designated schooling areas ONLY.** Please do not school or lunge on the grass!

## ANIMAL WELFARE

We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times while the horse is on the showgrounds we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. Exhibitors are cautioned that GR839 which defines the USEF's policy on abuse and GR803 which pertains to the use of whips, will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of a bamboo off-set, or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. Any handling and veterinary treatment should ensure their health and welfare. High standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be encouraged and maintained at all times. Adequate provision should be made for ventilation, feeding and watering and maintaining a healthy environment. Any method of riding and training should take account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered to be abusive. The well being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators are subject under the above rules to elimination from competition and to protest or charge with resulting formal proceedings which may result in severe fines, suspensions or other penalties.

## MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline, 2) exhibitions, 3) games and races, 4) classes for 4-H members, 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program), 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes, 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions, 8) opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA Beginner Novice division, and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

## MEASUREMENT & MEMBERSHIP CARDS

All ponies, junior hunters, and children's hunter ponies must present measurement cards or will be required to be measured. See Rule HU169. Each entry form must give the owners USEF/USHJA membership number, proper mailing address, telephone number and either a Social Security number or employer's Federal Identification Number. A copy of each owner's, trainer's, handler's and rider's USEF and USHJA membership cards must be presented to the Show Secretary before any numbers will be given out. Please send a copy of each with your entries.

## MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH GR1301.7

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

## SAFE SPORT STATEMENT

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. -Turn right into Fieldstone Show Park.





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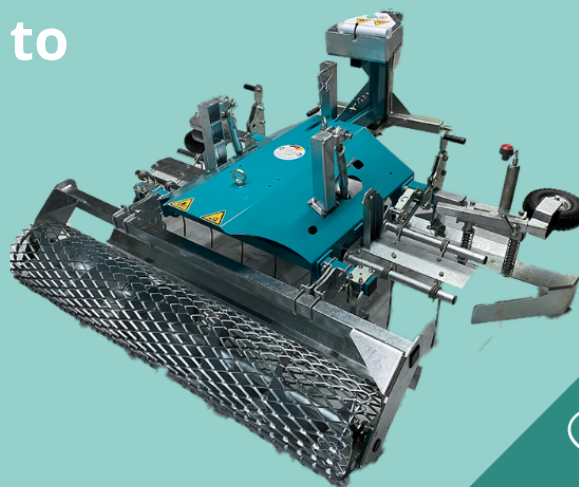
